### Important Exhibitor Information Creative Arts Department

**All exhibitors should read this information!**

**All exhibits in the Creative Arts Department s including Field Crops and Horticulture and Educational Booths should be pre-registered by August 12<sup>th</sup>. Creative Arts exhibits will check in and be judged prior to the opening day of the fair. Pre-registration of exhibits can be done online or with a paper entry form.**

The Fulton County Fair is now set up to take online entries and will accept online entries from **June 1<sup>st</sup> until August 12th**. Go to the Fulton County Fair website [www.fultoncountyfair.org](http://www.fultoncountyfair.org) and follow the link for online entries. Paper entries will also be accepted. An entry form is available on the website, at the fair office, or at the Fulton County Extension Office. All entries will be entered in the computer prior to check-in days and Entry Tags will be printed for the exhibits. Exhibits should be brought to the Hickinbotham-Miller Exhibit Building on the following days:

#### Check – In Dates

**Friday, August 19th – 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.**

**Note: Baked Items and Cut Flowers will be accepted on Monday, August 22 from 8:15 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. These exhibits should be pre-registered so that tags and judging forms can be printed prior to check-in.**

All Creative Arts exhibits will be judged on Monday, August 22nd and will be ready for public viewing on Tuesday, August 23rd. The exhibit building will open at 1:00 p.m. No one except fair workers will be allowed in the exhibit building on judging day.

Creative Arts exhibits will check out on Sunday, August 23rd from 1:00 to 3:00 p.m. All exhibitors should be present for check-out or make arrangements to have someone pickup their exhibits.

Exhibitors who want to send exhibits to the NCA District Fair should tell the department superintendent and remove the ribbons from the exhibit. Be sure the tag is left on the exhibit.
